Nomos's first ever wristwatch was the Tangente, designed in the clean style of the Deutscher Werkbund movement, which set the visual tone for the rest of its timepieces to follow. The exterior remains clean and clear, but inside, the Tangente now comes with an in-house-developed automatic movement. The 3.2mm-thick DUW 3001 has a 42-hour power reserve and bidirectional automatic winding. With such a slender movement, the Tangente Automatik comes in at a mere 6.9mm, only 0.3mm taller than the hand-wound version – and WIRED also approves of the modest case diameter of 35.5mm. £2,390 nomos-glashuette.com
